What do Pharmacy Technicians do?

Pharmacy technicians work under the direct supervision of a licensed pharmacist and perform many pharmacy-related functions. They refer any questions regarding prescriptions, drug information, or health matters to a pharmacist. Pharmacy techs work in a wide variety of practice settings, including community pharmacies, hospitals, the military, in-home health care settings, long term care facilities, mail service pharmacies, managed health care organizations and educational programs. Pharmacy technicians working in hospitals and other medical facilities prepare a greater variety of medications, such as intravenous medications. They may make rounds in the hospital, giving medications to patients.

Training & Educational Opportunities

You will have many employment opportunities as a pharmacy technician, but first you will need to complete training and earn a certificate. Coursework covers a variety of subjects, such as arithmetic used in pharmacies, recordkeeping, ways of dispensing medications and pharmacy law and ethics. Technicians also learn the names, uses and doses of medications.

As a Pharmacy Technician you will:

- Accept payment for prescriptions and process insurance claims
- Answer phone calls from customers
- Collect information needed to fill a prescription from customers or healthcare professionals
- Measure amounts of medication for prescriptions
- Package and label prescriptions
